The Queen's College Garden Play Funding

- Max Antoniou proposes that this JCR helps fund The Queen's College's Garden Play, 'Guys and Dolls', organised by the Eglesfield Musical Society.
- The production is an opportunity for a large number of students, both newcomers to the theatre scene and veterans, to get involved with all aspects of theatre. Funding this show would help support the arts scene in Oxford and continue the long legacy of the Eglesfield Musical Society. Due to its nature as a garden play, the production requires full lighting and sounding equipment, which comes with higher than usual costs.
- To support the costs of 'Guys and Dolls', including technical equipment, workshops with musical directors, and hiring an intimacy coordinator, this JCR resolves to give £100 to the production.

'Our House' Funding

- Aimée Dixson proposes that this JCR helps fund 'Our House', a student production running at the Oxford Playhouse during Week 4, Trinity.

- ‘Our House’ is a jukebox musical based on the music of Madness and is committed to providing as many students as possible with the creative opportunity to get involved in a Playhouse show, especially during the stresses of Trinity Term. The show also has public appeal, warranting higher spending on costume and sound production. Two St. Hilda’s students are members of the cast, and the proposer is a member of the crew.
- To support this production of ‘Our House’, this JCR resolves to give £150, to help fund the play.
