### **Motion One**

'The Seagull' Funding

- Rowan Brown proposes that this JCR helps fund the student production of Chekhov's 'The Seagull', playing at the Oxford Playhouse, MT26 W2.
- The production is committed to providing the opportunity to as many students as possible to get involved in a Playhouse show, no matter their experience, as student theatre should be accessible to all. The show will act as a welcoming event for freshers entering the university, as well as having a broad appeal to members of the public through the well-known name of Chekhov. Funding will help cover costs of production like sets, costumes, and sound. It will further help to demonstrate the ambition of the Oxford student drama scene, and to continue promoting the St. Hilda's drama scene.

### **Motion Two**

Oxford University Expedition to Kilimanjaro, in aid of Amnesty International

- Charlotte Allen proposes that this JCR helps support St. Hilda's students who are undertaking the Oxford University Expedition to Kilimanjaro, in aid of Amnesty International.
- The Oxford University Expedition to Kilimanjaro in aid of Amnesty International focuses on charitable fundraising and personal development. With four St Hilda's students taking part in the expedition this August – Charlotte Allen, Anna Hutchens, Sofia Lafontaine and Hattie Tyler – St Hilda's is notably represented in the group of approximately 35 students taking part. Contributing financially to their targets would support their goal of raising over £10,000 for Amnesty International in the final couple of weeks of fundraising.
- To support the expedition, this JCR resolves to give the remaining amount in the motions budget to Charlotte, Anna, Sofia and Hattie as a donation to Amnesty

International, split equally between their Just Giving pages, to help boost their fundraising ahead of their deadline later this month.
