### ***Motion One***

'Launa' Edinburgh Fringe Funding

- Rowan Brown proposes that this JCR helps fund the Edinburgh Fringe production of 'Launa' from the 7th-22nd of August 2026, following a successful run in Oxford.
- 'Launa' is an original piece of writing by a JCR member and taking it to the Fringe would help support ten early-career artists in transitioning from student to semi-professional theatre. Funds will be allocated towards venue cost, accommodation, marketing, and technical equipment, helping the production to achieve a professional standard in a new environment, and sharing the quality of Oxford's drama scene beyond the city.
- To support the Edinburgh Fringe run of 'Launa', this JCR resolves to give £100 to help cover the associated costs of the production.

- Kaelyn Jones and Esther Kim propose that this JCR supports The Turl Magazine.
- A recently revived student arts magazine with contributors from all colleges, Kaelyn and Esther are members of the events and design teams respectively. The magazine is an inclusive space for students to get involved in student journalism, helping to build a creative and inclusive space for students.
- InDesign, a crucial piece of software to lay in the magazine, is becoming increasingly expensive. The social aspect would also be aided by these funds, in keeping with the theme of this term's magazine 'Joy'
- To help mitigate the rising costs of InDesign, printing, and events, this JCR proposes to allocate £100 to fund The Turl.
